1. We approved the Minutes from January 29.
2. Annette Daoud informed us about her meeting with Gerardo Gonzalez, Interim Dean of Graduate Studies. Gerardo would like to change the formulation “project, National Board Certification Teacher (NBCT) process” to “project, including National Board Certification Teacher (NBCT) process”, this will affect the P2-Form for the **new option** and the C2-Form for the course **EDUC698**.
3. We discussed if certain references (to pending options and certificates) in the catalog copy for the **new option in Education** will appear in the final version. It was stated that these references in parentheses will not appear in the catalog copy.
4. UCC noticed that the approved changes for the courses **CS574** and **SOC442** will affect the programs Cognitive Science and Ethnic Studies. Because UCC would like to bring these two courses to the consent calendar on Wednesday we will inform the two programs about the change and David Barsky will wait with his signature until we get the signatures from these two programs.
5. David Barsky informed UCC that GEC has approved the course change to **CS100** and UCC added CS100 to the consent calendar.
6. UCC decided to add **VPA425** to the consent calendar with the changed title “Capstone Workshop” and UCC hopes that the Department of Visual and Performing Arts has no objections to this.
7. We discussed the new proposed certificate for **Advanced Study in Science Teaching**. Annette Daoud informed UCC that one sentence referring to the lack of content preparation will be deleted in the P-Form. David Barsky noted, that no catalog description was included. Annette Daoud will inform the UCC about further discussion about the courses **EDST591-593**.
8. UCC approved the P2-Form for **Political Science Major** and the two courses **PSCI439** and **PSCI493**.
9. David Barsky informed the UCC that now all signatures for the **P2-Form** for the **History Major** have been collected. UCC approved the P2-Form.
10. We started to discuss the proposed **Master of Social Work**. We began our discussion with general questions which we try to answer first: In which college will the Master of Social Work be located? Should there be a college review? The originator of the program is no longer at the university. Usually curriculum is proposed by faculty, will this affect the process? Can we get electronic copies of the submitted P-Form in order to mark changes more effectively?
