1. We approved the minutes from September 17 with a change in item 3, here we added the fact that UCC had a discussion about the requirement of adding SLOs to course proposals (C-Forms).
2. We discussed again the change of Special Major and reviewed the information we got about restriction, that the Special Major can not be used for a second bachelor's degree. It seems that the origin is unclear and UCC decided to remove this sentence.
3. We started the discussion about the new option "Global Supply Chain Management". UCC would like to get the signatures on the P-Form for the items 3.a-3.c. Virginia Mann will ask for the signatures. Robert Aboolian made it also clear that some courses in packet 2 are not directly related to this new option which explains why these courses are not mentioned in the P-Form. There were no more questions about the proposed new option beside the signatures. UCC will wait for BLP until we present the new option to the senate.

In item 3 of the P-Form it is also mentioned that the old "Supply Chain Management" track will be deleted once the new option is approved. It was not clear to UCC if this is already a formal request. The same happened in the P2-Form for the change of the Global Business Management Option (see http://www.csusm.edu/academic_programs/Curriculum_Review_06-07/CoBA/P2_GBM.pdf) UCC (David Barsky?) will ask the College of Business Administration to submit P2-Forms asking for deletion of the corresponding tracks with the understanding that these deletion forms will only be signed by UCC and David Barsky once the new options have been approved in senate.

4. We started to look at the new proposed P-Form template (http://www.calstate.edu/app/documents/Proposal_Format.doc) and compared it to the old P-Form (http://www.csusm.edu/academic_programs/Curriculum_Forms/New_Forms/New_Program_Template.doc).
