- 1) We approved the minutes from our February 25 meeting.
- 2) We discussed the answers from Kristin Moss and Michelle Holling to our questions about COMM456, COMM460, and COMM485. UCC decided that the sentence “Course restricted to students with junior or senior standing” should be added to these three courses. David Barsky pointed out that the phrase “or by consent of instructor” is always implicitly included now and will no longer appear in the catalog. UCC noticed that the course COMM456 should also get a signature from COBA, David Barsky sent an email to COBA to get this approval until Wednesday.
- 3) CHEM101 was approved after UCC looked at the proposed course changes for CHEM100, CHEM100L, and CHEM150.
- 4) PSCI368 was approved after a short discussion about the reasoning why no prerequisites are required for this course.
- 5) After a remark of David Barsky we went back and looked at the actions of UCC regarding VPA, as far as the members of UCC remembered for all courses proposed by VPA which were put on hold an email was sent to the originator and UCC still did not receive any response.
- 6) We continued the review of the Global Studies Major:
  - a) UCC would like to ask the originator to make sure that all requests from CAPC have been included, for example we did not find the Philosophy course on page 11.
  - b) On page 7 GBST400 appears as a core class, this does not agree with page 2 and the catalog copy. GBST400 appears more as a capstone class so it should not be a core class.
  - c) In table II the SLOs should be stated as short phrases, otherwise the table is hard to read.
  - d) Page 7, GBST300 is not a new class, the sentence should be deleted.
  - e) Page 8, the courses GBST399, GBST495, and GBST498 are nowhere mentioned in the catalog copy, course list, or Appendix D, how are these classes included in the curriculum?
  - f) The BB course in table D should be moved to the junior year.
  - g) UCC suggested that LTWR415 should be added to Geographic area “Middle East and North Africa” and HIST387 to the Global Issue area “International Law and Human Rights”.
  - h) UCC will check if each area has enough units without prerequisites.
