



How to log onto Empress


In cougarApps, I had already clicked on + and chosen the displayed items because they are needed for the class.



I started putty to logon to `empress.csusm.edu` with port 22. Click Open.



Now you are on Empress.



The Password does not echo.

When you see a prompt, (lower/upper cases do matter!!!!)

1. Create a class directory with your class name cs____ fill in the blank

```
mkdir cs__files
```

2. Enter the directory

```
cd cs__files
```

3. Copy all of my files to your directory (don't forget the period)

```
cp -r /cs/cs__RY/* .
```


4. See what you have in the directory

```
ls
```

g++ compiles the program producing a.out (Only list .C or .cpp files after g++)

Saying ./a.out will execute the program.

Now record the session as follows. The file name after "script" can be anything. Everything up to exit will be recorded in that file.



more recordinghw1

shows the content of the file (press Enter to go down to the next page)

logout

- make sure you always logout to leave Empress.

Try UNIX command such as

- **users** (you should see your name only once)
- **finger ryoshii**
