

Frequently Asked Questions Regarding Computer Science Internship

For international students:

Question: *Can international students get internship credits?*

Answer: Yes, as long as you have fulfilled all of the above requirements and can obtain a working permit from the Immigration Office.

Question: *Does the CS department help getting the working permit or practical training?*

Answer: No. The CS department has nothing to do with getting you a working permit or practical training. You will have to work with the Global Affairs Office to get a working permit or practical training. The CS Department only determines if the opportunity is worth any academic credits, and if so, evaluates the internship experience after it is completed. However, in recent years, the Foreign Student Advisor usually wants international student interns sign up for CS 495 before granting a working permit or curricular practical training.

Question: *If the CS department approves the internship credits, does it guarantee a working permit or practical training can be obtained?*

Answer: No.
